Mortal Remains Transferred from Bahrain to Puri



Dr Arun Kumar Praharaj, Odisha Mo Parivar's Single Point of Contact (SPOC), at Bahrain, paying condolences

Simanchala Rout of Khalikote block, Ganjam district who was working at Bahrain in a Pvt ltd company breathed his last on 8th August after suffering a brain haemorrhage due to high blood pressure.

Dr. Arun Kumar Praharaj, SPOC member of Odisha-Mo Parivar had been following the patient on a regular basis and extended all required assistance in the hospital for the treatment. Necessary arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from Bahrain to Bhubaneswar were made in co-ordination with Odisha-Mo Parivar team.

Convenor, Odisha-Mo Parivar, Senior Leader Sri Bharadwaj Mishra, Joint Secretaries (Odisha-Mo Parivar) Sri Rudra Narayan Samantray, Sri Sameer Pradhan and Odisha-Mo Parivar Health Advisor Sri Satyajit Dash received the mortal remains at Biju Patnaik International Airport. Thereafter the mortal remains were transferred to Swarga Dwar, Puri by an ambulance. Sri Stalin Parija, State Secretary (BYJD) remained with the family at Puri Swarga Dwara till the last rites were performed.

Mortal Remains of Odia Youth Brought Back From Bahrain

Jitu Swain of Khallikote block, Ganjam district who was working at Shams Almanar Blacksmith & the Welding & Fab, Bahrain died by suicide on 16 August. Jitu's cousin Prabhat informed regarding this matter to Dr. Arun Kumar Praharaj, who is appointed as the SPOC member by Odisha-Mo Parivar at Bahrain.

Dr Praharaj made necessary arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from Bahrain to Bhubaneswar airport.

Odisha-Mo Parivar after receiving the mortal remains at the Biju Patnaik international Airport arranged an ambulance to further transfer to his native at Ganjam. MLA Khallikote Smt Suryamani Baidya stood by the family members and assisted in conducting the last rites.

Five workers from Gunupur in Rayagada district and one worker from Gajapati district succumbed to the injuries due to a fire caused by short circuit at a shrimp farm in Guntur district of Andhra Pradesh.

After getting the information from the Chief Minister's Residence Office, Odisha-Mo Parivar along with Gunupur MLA Shri Raghunath Gomango immediately coordinated with the local police in Andhra Pradesh and urged them to expedite the legal process. Arrangements were made for the family members of the deceased to travel to Guntur for conducting the last rites. Shri Gomango accompanied the family members and stood by them till the last rites were performed.

Thereafter, the family members returned to their native place and Odisha-Mo Parivar Convenor paid a visit to Gunupur to offer condolences and provided financial assistance to the bereaved family on behalf of the Honorable Chief Minister.

Differently abled yet mentally strong

Parbati Nayak a 55 year old widow, residing at Puri was abandoned by her both sons, but was being taken care of by her daughter Nimal Nayak, who is differently abled.

Nimal, being the sole bread winner of the house was out of town for a work. On 8th July, she got a call from her neighbor that her mother was not well. She immediately returned to her hometown and admitted her mother in Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar. There, she got to know that her mother is suffering from a brain stroke. After being treated for 4 days, the doctor advised to shift her to AIIMS Bhubaneswar as there was no sign of improvement in her condition.

After reaching AIIMS, Nimal felt helpless and was down with fever and was sitting in a corner seeking help to admit her mother. Our helpdesk operator Somnath Swain saw them and immediately sprang into action. He helped them with all navigational and admission related process. Presently the patient is under observation and a regular follow-up is being maintained by the helpdesk operator.

Even though they are appointed at different locations, yet they sort out the problems by proper coordination amongst themselves. Two such cases were witnessed in the month of August which were intervened by helpdesk operators with proper coordination.

1 Himadri Sunani, a 21 year old national level badminton player, had been to Bhawanipatna for a training program. There she suddenly fell ill and was shifted to DHH Bhawanipatna. The doctor diagnosed that her sugar level had increased drastically and she was in need of an ICU bed, which was not available at DHH Bhawanipatna. Hence, the doctor advised to shift her to VIMSAR, Burla for better treatment. Helpdesk operator Rojalin Panda helped the attendant of the patient in the entire process and also made arrangements to shift the patient from the hospital to Burla. Upon reaching at VIMSAR Burla, our helpdesk operator Dhirendra Suna helped the attendant in the admission procedure and kept a regular follow-up with the patient.

2 In a domestic gas cylinder explosion 8 persons from Gambharimunda village, Banpur were seriously injured. Out of the 8, seven people had 90% burn injuries and were sent to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar and one person to SCB, Cuttack. The family of the patient, referred to SCB requested to shift the patient to AIIMS itself, so that all the victims get treatment together at same place. Hence, meticulous planning was done to shift the patient from SCB to AIIMS in the wee hours.

Helpdesk operators Sandeep Rath & Santosh Das of SCB-Cuttack, Bikash Behera of Capital Hospital and Somnath Swain of AIIMS, Bhubaneswar coordinated the entire process and shifted the patient and completed the admission procedure in a hassle free manner. MLA Chilika Sri Prasant Kumar Jagdev and Convenor Odisha-Mo Parivar paid a visit to the hospital to have a detailed discussion with the doctor and also consoled the family

Major interventions by Helpdesk operators in the month of August

1 // Sudarsan Maharana, (35) , of Khorda district suffering from an infection in the pancreas was admitted to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar on 18th August. He was shifted to ICU when the infection started to spread to multiple organs and his oxygen level dropped. Helpdesk operator Somnath Swain kept a regular follow-up with the patient. He also helped the attendant of the patient to enroll the patient's name under BSKY Scheme. The patient has recovered and has been shifted to the general ward.

2 // 63-year-old Kanakalata Mallick of Jagatsinghpur, suffering from blood cancer was admitted to SUM Hospital, Bhubaneswar. Helpdesk operator Siba Prasad Rout helped the patient's family to enroll the patient under BSKY Scheme. The patient is undergoing chemotherapy at the hospital and a regular follow-up is being maintained by the Helpdesk operator.

3 // Anil Rohi of Jharsuguda was suffering from blood cancer and admitted to SUM Hospital, Bhubaneswar. Helpdesk operator Siba Prasad Rout helped the patient's attendant to enroll the patient under BSKY Scheme. During the course of treatment there was requirement of 4 units of AB+ve Blood & 6 RDP, which was arranged by our helpdesk operator. Despite the best efforts of the doctor, Anil lost his life. After his demise, the helpdesk operator also made necessary arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from the hospital to their native at Jharsuguda.

4 // Subash Dalai of Purusottampur, Ganjam district met with an accident and was admitted to MKCG, Berhampur but died while undergoing treatment. The family was under financial stress to transfer the mortal remains back to their native place. The family reached out to MLA Sri Bikram Kumar Panda who further informed our helpdesk operator Girija Satpathy to look after the case. Thereafter, Girija stood by the family and made all required arrangements including the documentation process at the hospital, paper work at police station and ensured an ambulance free of cost

Presently she has been admitted to SCB, Cuttack for plastic surgery. Her surgery was due because her family couldn't arrange the required blood. Upon getting the information, our Helpdesk operator Sandeep, reached out to them and arranged one unit of O+ve blood for her surgery.

Out of the three, Tanmay's health condition was serious, the doctor advised to shift him to Vizag for further treatment. The helpdesk operator made logistical arrangements for the same.

7 // Saroj Bal, a 49-yr-old resident of Jajpur District was admitted to SUM Hospital. His hemoglobin level had drastically dropped and he was in dire need of 2 units of B+ve blood. Helpdesk operator Siba Prasad Rout, arranged one donor and himself donated one unit of blood for the patient. The family members expressed gratitude to Siba for helping them out and donating blood.

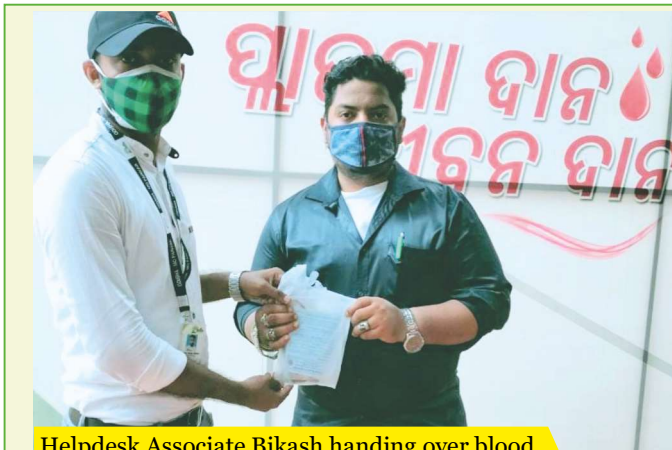

8 // 52-days-old, Tej Prakash Das of Balasore District suffering from Pneumonia was admitted to SUM Hospital, Bhubaneswar. Earlier, MLA Sri Swarup Das had extended financial help for the treatment of the child. After being treated for 4 days, the child recovered but the family was under financial stress to clear the hospital dues. Helpdesk operator Siba Prasad Rout explained the situation to hospital superintendent Dr Pusparaj and requested him to waive off the remaining dues. Thus, looking into the matter and keeping the request, the balance dues were waived off by the hospital due to which the family members expressed gratitude to the Helpdesk operator and Odisha-Mo Parivar.

9 // A two-year-old child, Girija Nayak of Balasore district suffering from blood cancer is undergoing treatment at SUM, Hospital Bhubaneswar. The helpdesk operator helped the family to enroll the patient under BSKY Scheme, as they were completely unaware of the scheme. Siba arranged a B+ve donor for the patient during the course of the treatment and follow-up is being maintained with the patient.

11 // 35-year-old, Smt Kumari Patel of Dharmagarh, Kalahandi District had a hole in her heart and was admitted to SCB, Cuttack. Kumari's family had approached Dharmagarh MLA Sri Mousadhi Bag for help, who further intimated our helpdesk operators Sandeep Rath regarding the case and asked to look into it. Both the helpdesk operator at SCB, Sandeep and Santosh kept a regular follow-up with the patient. During the course of the treatment, the patient was in need of 5 units of B+ve blood which was arranged by our helpdesk operator. After being treated for around one month, the patient recovered and was discharged. The family members were thankful for the timely help rendered by our helpdesk operators.

12 // 24-year-old boy, Premapara Bhoi of Nuapada District was suffering from severe abdominal pain and was admitted to VIMSAR Burla. There the doctor advised to undergo surgery, since the pain was due to the accumulation of stone in his stomach. Her family were under stress as they were unable to arrange the required blood for her surgery, which came into the notice of our Helpdesk operator Dharendra Suna, stationed at Burla hospital, who immediately arranged 2 units of A+ve blood for the surgery.

13 // 50-year-old, Uday Nath Tudu of Jagannathpur, Mayurbhanj district, was admitted to PRMMCH, Baripada. He was diabetic and a small injury on his right leg feet developed into a severe infection. Hence, the doctor advised for the amputation of his left foot in order to stop the infection from spreading to the rest part of his body. The Helpdesk operator Ashis Rana attended the patient and helped him throughout the process. Also one unit of O+ve was arranged by the Helpdesk operator during the surgery.

During the course of her treatment her haemoglobin dropped drastically, for which she was in dire need of blood. Since her blood group was rare O-ve, it was difficult at the end of her family to arrange the required blood. Our helpdesk operator Sandeep Rath, upon getting the information regarding the same arranged one unit of the rare O-ve blood in the nick of time.

15 // Akash Bal, an 11-year-old boy of Balasore district was suffering from cancer in his left leg and was admitted to AIIMS Bhubaneswar on 2nd August. Since the family were unaware about the benefits of BSKY Scheme, our Helpdesk operator Somnath Swain helped to register the patient under the scheme for further treatment. In order to stop the further spread of cancer, the doctor amputated his left foot. Two units of A+ve blood were required for the operation, which was arranged by our helpdesk operator. The patient after being treated for 15 days, recovered and has been discharged.

All BSKY Smart Card holders and NFSA/ SFSA card holder are eligible to avail the special health coverage, for which State Government will bear the cost.

Families covered under NFSA / SFSA with in Odisha are auto-enrolled under this scheme.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who is there to facilitate at point of service?

Swasthya Mitras are deployed at each help desk of empanelled private hospitals to facilitate the beneficiaries.

2. During emergency can I avail cashless treatment at any empanelled hospitals without carrying a card?

Yes, all BSKY Smart Card holders are eligible to avail the cashless treatment at empanelled private hospitals even during emergencies, provided they submit the BSKY Smart Card at the counter within 72 hours of hospitalization.

3. How many members in a family are eligible to avail cashless treatment under BSKY at empanelled private hospitals?

All the registered family members under NFSA/ SFSA who are issued with BSKY Smart Card, are eligible to avail the scheme.

4. How to get duplicate BSKY card if original card is lost/ damaged?

If a beneficiary either loses/ damages his / her card then the same can be obtained from nearest Mo Seva Kendra by producing his/her NFSA/ SFSA (Ration) card.

5. How to get card related information and also rectify errors in the card such as adding or deleting a member from card?

Card related information can be accessed from the web-portal "bsky.odisha.gov.in" or from Mo Seva Kendra service point. Any error relating to card can be rectified at Mo Seva Kendra after producing NFSA/SFSA (Ration) card.

6. Where to get the list of empanelled hospitals for availing health-related services using BSKY Smart Health Card?

The list of empanelled hospitals within or outside the state is available in the web portal "bsky.odisha.gov.in".

7. How do we calculate annual coverage amount for male and female member of the family?

If in a family, there are two members, one male member and another woman member then,

- If a male member falls sick and exhausts Rs 3 Lakh from BSKY Smart Health card and then the woman member falls sick, she can avail upto Rs 7 lakh under the card.
- If a male member doesn't fall sick and only the female member of the family falls sick, she can avail upto Rs 10 lakh under the card.
- If a woman member falls sick and exhausts Rs 3 lakh from BSKY smart health card, then if a male members falls sick, he can avail Rs 2 lakh from the card.

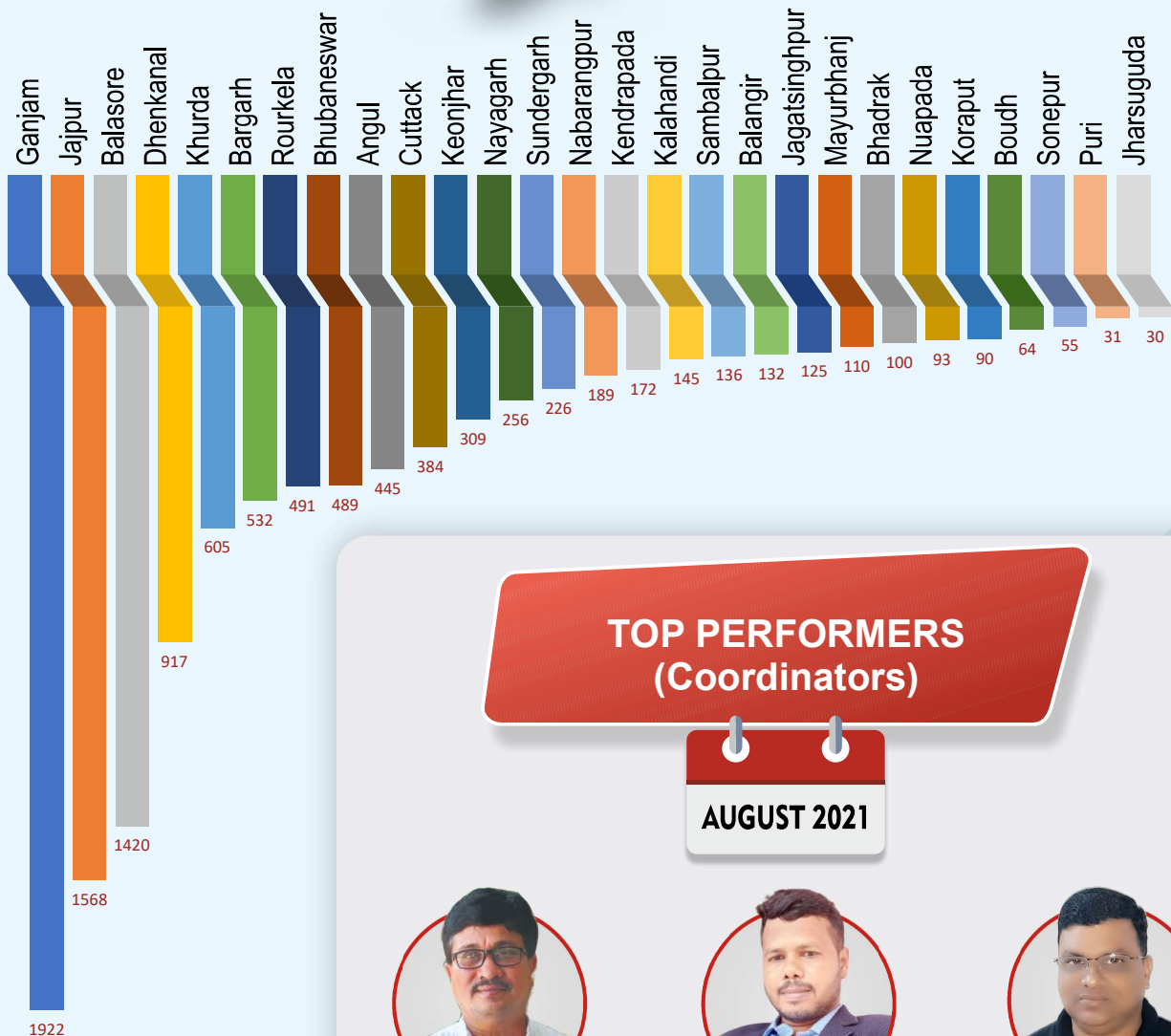
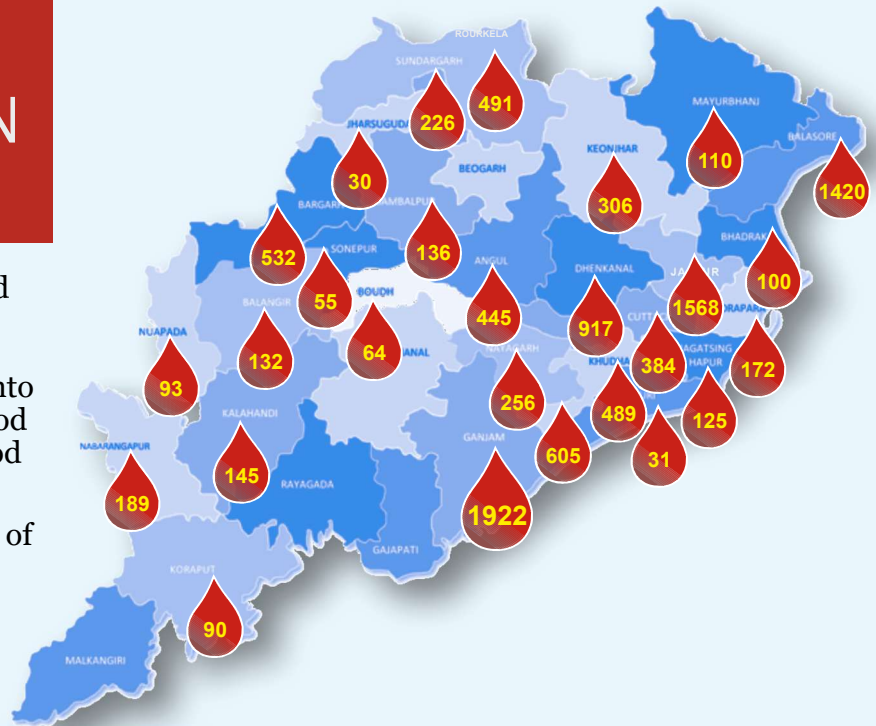
8. Is there a feedback mechanism in the BSKY?

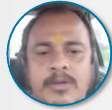
