Mortal Remains Of A Vendor Transferred To His Village From Kolkata

Pradyumna Kumar Ghadei, a resident of Kendrapada was staying in Kolkata for a long time, earning his living by running a snack shop at Kumarahati, Kolkata. On 23rd November, he suddenly fell down while offering

prayers at his shop. He was taken to a nearby hospital by the local people but unfortunately, he was declared dead due to a cardiac arrest. His family, at his native place, were under financial

During the discussion at office regarding the case, our office assistant Sri Sanjay Samantaray came forward to donate blood for the patient on his own will. Arrival of mortal remains from Kerala and transferring to Bhadrak

Amar Kumar Sankhua, a resident of Bhadrak, was working in a pvt. ltd. company in Kerala for the last 2 years. While working on the site, he met with an accident that led to severe injuries in his spinal cord.

Unfortunately, after undergoing treatment for around 20 days, he breathed his last on 17th November. The family somehow made the logistical arrangement to transfer the mortal remains from Kerala to Bhubaneswar via Air but were under financial burden to travel to their native place. They approached MLA and member of Odisha-Mo Parivar, Sri Sanjeev Mallick to help them.

He was rushed to MKCG, Berhampur but was referred to a private hospital at Visakhapatnam since his health was deteriorating. Unfortunately after undergoing treatment for 4 days, he succumbed to his ailments. Though he was entitled to get treated under the BSKY scheme, but due to certain rules the case couldn't be covered under the scheme and the family had to continue the treatment paying the required amount. Since there were some dues to be cleared, the hospital authority was not



handing over the body to the family.

The family was under financial stress and approached MLA Smt. Latika Pradhan to help them. Upon getting the information from Smt. Pradhan, our helpdesk associate Prakash Behera was intimated to attend the family.

Prakash reached the hospital and discussed with the authorities, after which the due amount was reduced and the body was handed over to the family.

Prakash also helped the family in making logistical arrangements to return to their native place in Ganjam.

Mortal remains transferred from Berhampur to Koraput

Manoranjan Behera, a 50-year-old resident of Koraput, was admitted to MKCG, Berhampur for the treatment.

Unfortunately, he breathed his last while undergoing treatment. The family approached Baikuntha Mandal, our helpdesk associate at Koraput seeking help to transfer the mortal remains. Baikuntha discussed the matter with Girija Satpathy, helpdesk associate at MKCG.

Girija intimated the matter to MLA Sri Bikram Panda, who immediately made the required arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from the hospital to their native place at Koraput.
