# Mortal Remains Brought Back From Goa

**M**ukunda Nayak, a 24-year-old from Digapahandi, Ganjam was working at a restaurant at Goa for the last 13 years.

Unfortunately, he breathed his last on 2<sup>nd</sup> December due to heart-attack. The restaurant

owner made logistical arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from Goa to Bhubaneswar by Air.

The family was unable to arrange logistics to transfer the mortal remains from the airport to their native place, due to their poor financial condition and adverse weather conditions in wake of cyclone Jawad.

Upon getting the information from Hon'ble Speaker Sri Surjya Narayan Patro, Odisha-Mo Parivar made logistical arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from the Bhubaneswar International airport to their native place at Digapahandi, Ganjam.

**S**ushant Kumar Rout was working with Delta Construction Co WLL, Bahrain, as a Plumber for the past 6 years. Due to irregular payment of salary, he had resigned on 30th July 2021, but his contractual dues were not settled.

Unfortunately, his sister breathed her last in the last week of November and he desperately wanted to return to his native place in Odisha.

Dr. Arun Kumar Praharaj, Odisha-Mo Parivar SPOC Member at Bahrain intervened in the matter and made all required arrangements to send Mr. Sushant back to Odisha in coordination with Indian Embassy.

Odisha-Mo Parivar team received Sushant at the Bhubaneswar Airport and made logistical arrangements to send him back to his native place at Kendrapara.

On November 26th, 18 passengers from Gopalpur, Ganjam district, were returning in a mini bus after a pilgrimage to Ghatagaon Maa Tarini at Keonjhar.

At around 2:30 that night, 13 people came out to take a break at the Balugaon bypass road, while 5 others were inside the mini bus. At that point, a truck came from behind and hit the minibus parked there.

Out of the 5 inside the minibus, 3 died at the spot and 2 persons namely, Balaji Patra (50) and

Basudeb Sahu (38), were taken to a local hospital in a critical condition. Later they were shifted to Hi-Tech Medical College & Hospital, Bhubaneswar.

After recovery, they were seeking logistical help to return to their native place, which was intimated by Sri Sashi Bhusan Mohanty to Odisha-Mo Parivar.

Two ambulances were arranged by Odisha-Mo Parivar to shift both the patients from Hi-Tech Hospital to their native place at Gopalpur, Ganjam.

V. Ramakrishna & his wife V. Damayanti, of Ganjam district suffering from severe burn injuries, were admitted to SCB, Cuttack. Unfortunately, during the course of the treatment, V. Ramakrishna succumbed to his injuries. Our helpdesk associate Sandeep and Santosh made

logistical arrangements to transfer the mortal remains of V. Rama - krishna from SCB, Cuttack to their native place at Ganjam. They also maintained a follow-up with V. Damayanti and arrangements were made to send her back to their native place after her recovery.

## Major Interventions through Helpdesk

### 1. Rare Blood Cases

- Sandeep Sahu, a 17-year-old resident of Dhenkanal, suffering from anemia was admitted to SCB, Cuttack.
- Our helpdesk associate Sandeep Rath stationed at SCB Hospital ensured proper treatment of the patient and also arranged one unit of rare B-ve blood for the patient, required during the treatment.

- Anjan Jena, a 45-year-old resident of Jagatsinghpur with renal calculus was admitted to Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar for his surgery.
- Our helpdesk associate Bikash Behera attended the patient and also arranged one unit of rare B-ve blood required during the surgery.

- Mamata Samal, a 40-year-old woman of Banki, suffering from anemia was admitted to SCB, Cuttack.
- There was a dire need of 2 units of AB+ve blood for the patient. Our Helpdesk associate Sandeep Rath arranged 2 units of rare AB+ve blood for the patient & ensured proper treatment of the patient.

- A 70-year-old anemic patient Sakhi Nayak of Khordha was admitted to Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar.
- There was an urgent need of rare B-ve blood for the patient. Our helpdesk associate Bikash Behera after getting the information, immediately arranged one unit of B-ve blood for the patient.



- Jogeswari Panda, a 68-year-old woman of Sambalpur suffering from brain tumor, was admitted to VIMSAR, Burla.
- Our helpdesk associate Dhirendra is maintaining a regular follow-up with the patient and has also arranged rare AB+ve blood required for the patient during the course of treatment.

- An 11-year-old anemic patient Chularaj Gahir of Parmandpur was admitted to DHH, Bhawanipatna.
- There was a dire need of rare AB+ve blood for the patient but the family was unable to arrange the same. Our helpdesk associate Rojalin Panda after getting the information, immediately arranged one donor for the patient.

## 2. Navigating the Unattended

- Veteran Odia actress Smt. Meera Mohanty, who is going through a very difficult phase in her life was admitted to SCB, Cuttack suffering from fever and abdominal pain.
- Our helpdesk associate Santosh at SCB Hospital ensured proper treatment of Smt. Mohanty and facilitated all required medical assistance at the hospital.

- Sangram Patsani, an 11-year-old boy suffering from thalassemia had been to DHH, Puri along with his mother. There was a dire need of blood transfusion on the day due to drop in the haemoglobin level.
- His mother was unable to arrange the same and somehow came in contact with our helpdesk associate Biswo, who immediately arranged 3 units of blood for the thalassemia patient.

- Tapan Kumar Bhue, a 50-year-old man of Khordha met with an accident and was admitted to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.
- There was an urgent need of a surgery of the patient. Our helpdesk associate Somnath after getting the information regarding the patient, immediately reached out to the concerned doctor and facilitated in the process for the surgery on an immediate basis.

- Puspa Ganda, an 18-year-old girl suffering from diabetes was admitted to SLNMCH, Koraput. She was along with her elderly grandmother at the hospital.
- Our helpdesk associate Baikuntha had been attending the patient and during the discharge he also arranged funds for them to travel back to their home.

- Kailash Mohanty, a resident of Berhampur suffering from cardiac arrest was admitted to MKCG, Berhampur.
- The doctor advised to shift the patient to a private hospital at Vizag for further treatment. But the family was under financial stress. Our helpdesk associate Girija after getting the information, coordinated with MLA Sri Bikram Panda, who provided financial assistance to shift the patient from MKCG, Berhampur to Vizag.

- Akshaya Bhoi, a visually challenged person visited Capital Hospital for doctor's consultation.
- Our helpdesk associate Rashmi Behera stationed at the hospital attended the patient and ensured hassle-free treatment and also helped him in all documentation process for availing disability certificate.



## 3. Logistical Help Provided

- Bishnuprasad Mohapatra, a 42-year-old resident of Puri had met with an accident and was admitted to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.
- He breathed his last while undergoing treatment. The deceased's family was under financial stress and was seeking help to transfer the mortal remains. Our helpdesk associate Somanth upon getting the information, made logistical arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from AIIMS, Bhubaneswar to their native place at Puri.

- Hamid Mohammad a 50-year-old man of railway colony, Puri met with a road accident and was admitted to DHH, Puri.
- Our helpdesk associate Biswo attended the patient and facilitated in all required medical assistance. Later, as per the advice of the doctor, logistical arrangements were also done by Biswo to shift the patient from DHH, Puri to SCB, Cuttack for further treatment.

- Sone Singh, a 45-year-old accident victim was admitted to PRMMCH, Baripada.
- Our helpdesk associate had attended the patient, facilitated in all required medical assistance and arranged required blood for the patient during treatment. Unfortunately, the patient didn't survive. Later Asish made logistical arrangements to transfer the mortal remains of the deceased from PRMMCH to his native place.

## 4. Treatment Under BSKY

- Nakula Gouda, 59-year-old resident of Ganjam district was admitted to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar for his heart surgery.
- Our helpdesk associate Somnath Swain maintained a regular follow-up with the patient and also facilitated in all documentation process of the patient for his treatment under BSKY Scheme.

- Deepanjali Sa, 47-year-old resident of Themra sadar, suffering from gynaecological issues had been to DHH, Bhawanipatna for doctor's consultation.

- Prasant Mohan Das, a 37-year-old resident of Bhubaneswar was admitted to SUM, Hospital for his Cardiothoracic and Vascular Surgery.
- There was a dire need for 6 units of O+ve blood and 4 units of RDP and 2 units of FFP for his surgery. Our helpdesk associate Siba Prasad Rout arranged donor for the patient in the nick of time and also registered the patient for treatment under BSKY scheme.

Our helpdesk associate Rojalin attended the patient, helped the family in all documentation process for the treatment under BSKY scheme and also made logistical arrangements to shift the patient from DHH, Bhawanipatna to Cuttack.



## Standing By The Needy Patients



**S**ulochana Patnaik, a 40-year-old breast cancer patient from Aathagarh in Cuttack district, who was under financial stress to receive treatment, had approached Sri Sameer Pradhan (Joint secretary Odisha-Mo Parivar).

Upon getting the information the case was immediately taken up and she was brought to Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar for her treatment. Helpdesk associate Bikash Behera at Capital Hospital, helped the patient in all medical assistance and later as per the doctor's advice, she

was shifted to SUM, Hospital for further treatment. She had been undergoing chemotherapy and radiations at SUM Hospital since last September and our helpdesk associate Siba Prasad Rout stationed at the hospital has been maintaining a regular follow-up with the patient.

Also Smt. Patnaik has been provided with artificial hair wig by team Odisha-Mo Parivar in coordination with Konark Cancer Foundation.

A native of Banki in Cuttack District, he has been residing at Kargil Basti, Bhubaneswar since 2002. Being the only breadwinner of the family, he had initially started a fruit and vegetable business.

Looking at the difficulties faced by the differently-abled people, the non-acceptance of the mentally-challenged individuals in the society, Trilochan decided to dedicate his life to serve the unattended. In the year 2012, he fell off a coconut tree and fractured his backbone, where the

doctor pronounced that he might not be able to walk again. But Trilochan took this situation as a challenge. He rented an Auto and wherever he came across helpless & differently-abled people, he used to drop them at their destination free of cost & also take the needy people to hospital whenever needed.

His auto-rickshaw is equipped with a wheelchair, a stretcher and a first-aid kit to help needy people. Trilochan also participates in rallies and awareness programs organized for the disabled. He focuses on how to help the needy and differently-abled people to ensure that they avail benefits from the Government schemes and Non-Government Organizations.

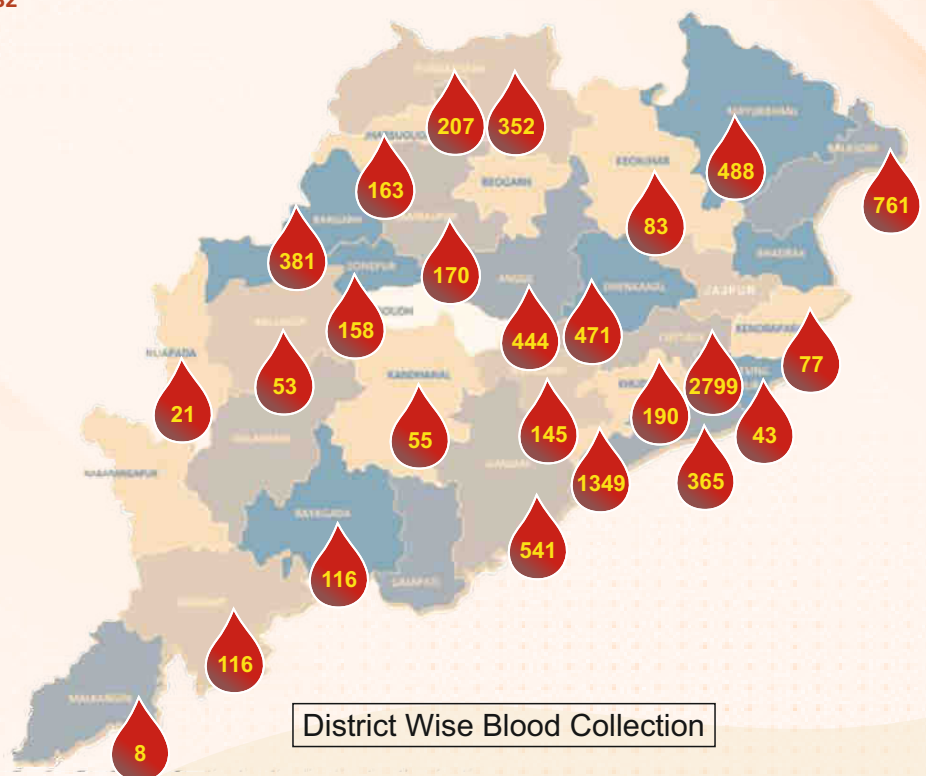
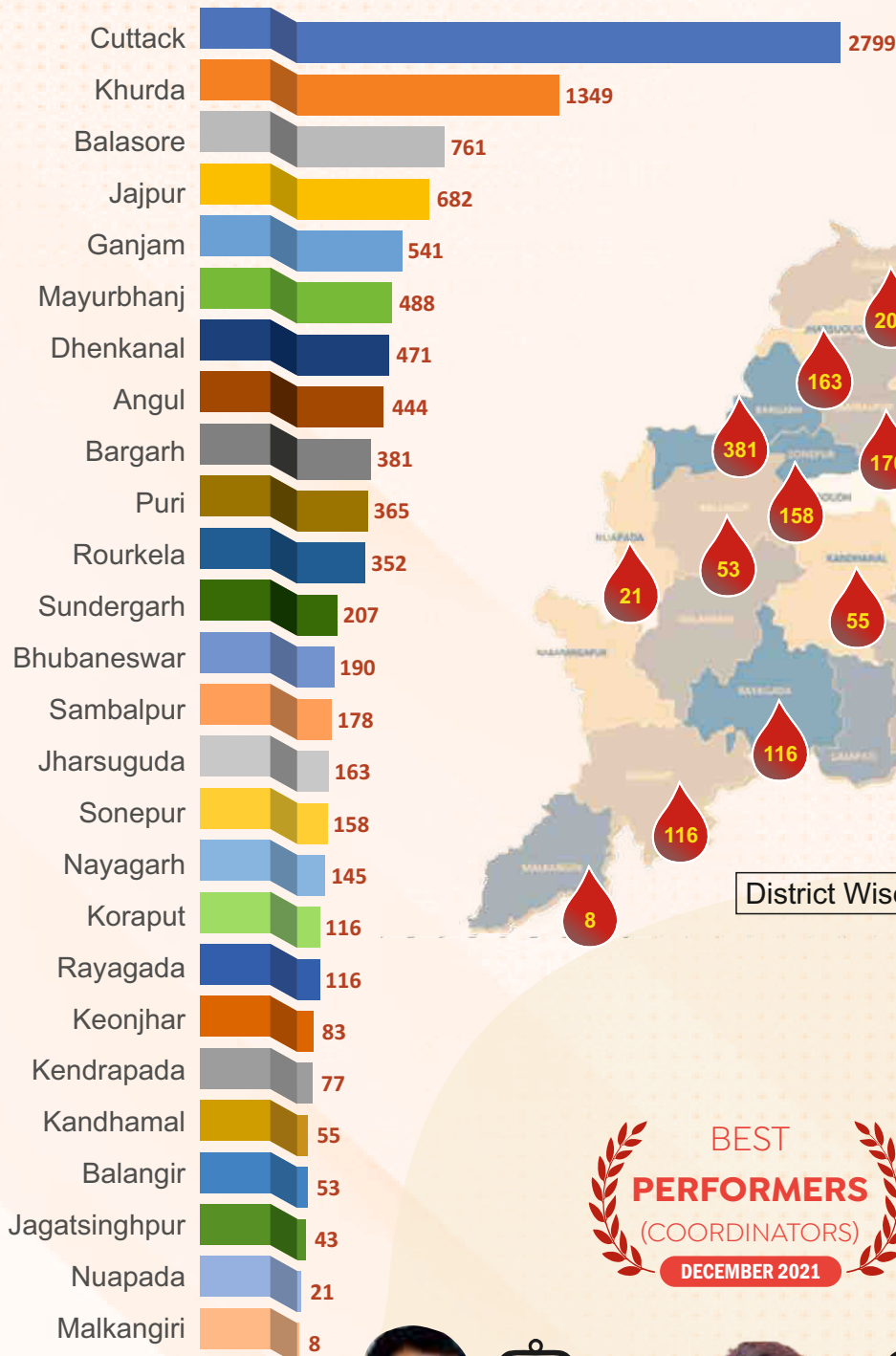

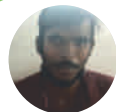
