Rescued From Bahrain

Sipra Sahu, a 43-year-old resident of Jajpur was working in Bahrain for the past few years. In the month of January 2023, her VISA expired and she intimated the same to her employer.

Instead of helping her out in this matter, the employer abandoned her. Feeling helpless, she decided to return to her native place.

When she approached the concerned authority to renew her VISA, she was tortured and detained by the department and was left utterly helpless for around a month. Somehow, she came in contact with Dr. Arun Praharaj, SPOC (Odisha-Mo Parivar) in Bahrain, who immediately intervened in the matter and coordinated with the police and immigration authorities. Then he booked an air ticket and arranged a temporary passport (exit pass) from the Indian embassy.

After reaching at Bhubaneswar airport, she was reunited with her family and returned to her native place at Jajpur. Odisha-Mo Parivar team was present at the

airport to receive her and the family expressed their immense gratitude for helping them in bringing their daughter back home safely.

Last Rites Of Unattended And Unidentified Bodies Performed

Odisha- Mo Parivar has stepped in to conduct the last rites of unidentified and unattended bodies recovered at various places of the city. Following cases were addressed in the month of January.

1 Two elderly persons staying at a rehabilitation centre who were mentally-challenged, were undergoing treatment at Capital hospital and unfortunately breathed their last on 8th January.

Since, no information could be gathered about their family, the bodies were kept unattended for more than 72 hours. The rehabilitation centre approached Odisha-Mo Parivar and intimated about the matter.

2 On 14th January, the body of a 35-year-old was found in the Kuakhai river under the jurisdiction of the Mancheswar police station. The body was kept at Capital Hospital for identification. Since, there was no claimant, the police informed the matter to Odisha-Mo Parivar.

3 The dead body of a 35-year-old woman was found lying near the Kalarahanga level crossing. Seeing this, the local people called 108 ambulance and the body was shifted to Capital Hospital for post-mortem with the help of the police.



Upon getting information about the above cases, Odisha-Mo Parivar team reached at the hospital and the bodies were taken to the Satyanagar crematorium in Jai Odisha's hearse vehicle 'Sesha Saathi', where the last rites were performed by the police and Odisha-Mo Parivar team.

T-Bangarama, a 53-year-old resident of Bhubaneswar, met with an accident and was taken to Capital hospital for emergency treatment by few passer-by. Unfortunately, he succumbed to his injuries. The bereaved family approached our joint secretary Sri Rudra Samantaray seeking help for the last rites.

Upon getting the information, Odisha-Mo Parivar team reached at the hospital and helped in the required documentation process and later the body was shifted to Satyanagar crematorium through Jai Odisha's hearse vehicle 'Sesha Saathi', where the last rites were conducted.

The family expressed their gratitude to Odisha-Mo Parivar for standing by them during their time of need.

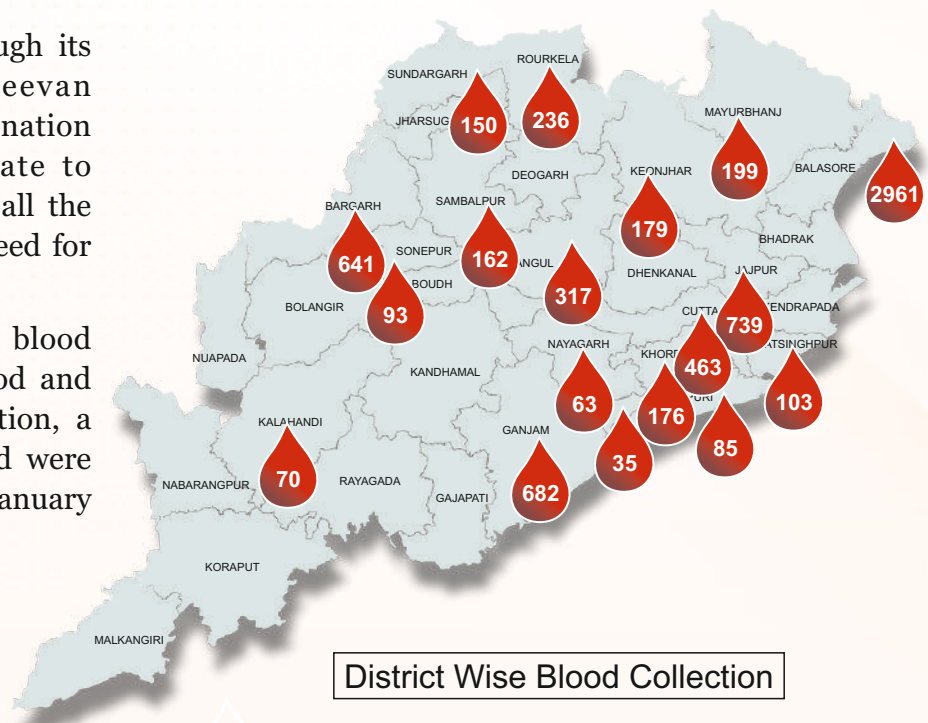

Prosthetics Support By Odisha-Mo Parivar

1. Muralidhar Khatua

Muralidhar Khatua, a 49-year-old resident of Cuttack was working at Pune, where he met with an accident in 2015 and suffered severe injuries on his left leg. He was admitted to a nearby hospital but unfortunately, the injuries led to infection which was advised to be amputated by the doctor.

After that he returned to his native place at Cuttack and due to his disability he got completely dependent upon his family.

Upon getting the information regarding provision of prosthetics by Odisha-Mo Parivar, he approached us through Sri Suman Sahoo (BCJD) and was referred to ARC, Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar for measurements. After receiving prosthetics he expressed his gratitude for the same and gathered self-confidence that he can again become capable of resuming his work.



2. Arun Kumar Sahoo

Arun Kumar Sahoo, a 52-year-old resident of Cuttack had a thorn pierced on his right leg which later got infected. In August 2022 he had to undergo a surgery at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar where unfortunately the doctor advised for amputation in order to stop the infection to spread to further parts of the body.

Later, he approached Suman Sahoo (BCJD) seeking help for prosthetics and he was guided to visit ARC, Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar for measurement. After receiving prosthetics, he expressed his gratitude for the same.

3. Trilochan Behera

Trilochan Behera, a 40-year-old resident of Cuttack met with a bike accident in July 2020, where his right leg got injured. He couldn't get proper treatment of his leg, due to COVID, which later got infected. In 2021 the doctor advised for amputation to stop the infection to spread further.

Upon getting the information regarding provision of prosthetics by Odisha-Mo Parivar, he had approached us through Sri Suman Sahoo and he was referred to ARC, Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar for measurement. After receiving prosthetics, he expressed his gratitude for the same.

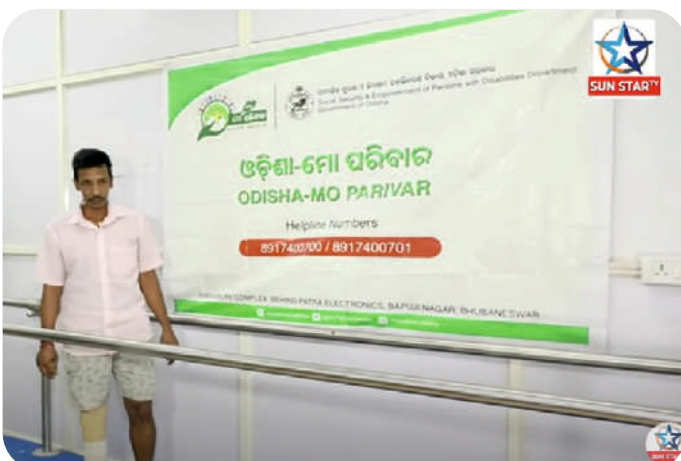
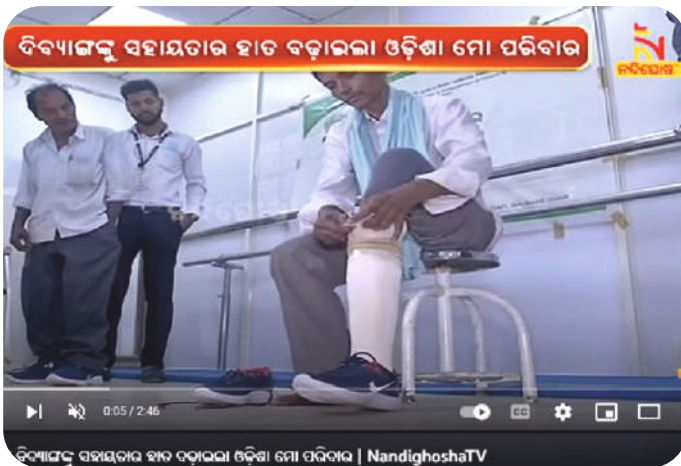
