Mortal Remains Of Odia Youth Brought Back From Oman

No Distance Too Far

Pradip Pahan, an Odia worker of Kamalapadar village, Ganjam district was working at Dolphin Trading & Investment LLC, Muscat, Oman, breathed his last after he met with an accident on 14th September 2021.

Dr Arun Kumar Praharaj, who is appointed as the SPOC member by Odisha-Mo Parivar at Bahrain, stepped in to resolve the matter in co-ordination with the External Affairs Ministry of India, Rajya Sabha MP Dr. Sasmit Patra and Embassy of India – Muscat.

Arrangements were made to transfer the mortal remains from Oman to Bhubaneswar via Mumbai. Odisha-Mo

Parivar team received the mortal remains at Biju Patnaik International Airport and made logistical arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from the airport to Kamalapadar, Ganjam.

Mortal Remains Of Odia Worker Brought Back From Delhi To Odisha

Bichitrnanda Patra of Tanupur village in Patamundai, Kendrapara district, was working as a plumber in New Delhi.

On 20th of September, while offering the morning prayers, the 58-year old suddenly fell on ground and sustained a head injury, which resulted in his death.

Odia Mahamanch, New Delhi in coordination with Sri Akshay Samal, SPOC member Odisha-Mo Parivar at Delhi, assisted in completing all the legal procedures.

As the family were financially incompetent to transfer the mortal remains, financial assistance was provided to transfer the mortal remains from Delhi to Odisha.

Logistical Arrangements Made

45-year-old, B Iswari Reddy of Ganjam district had met with an accident and was undergoing treatment at MKCG, Berhampur.

Since there was no sign of improvement in her health condition, the doctor advised to shift her to SCB, Cuttack.

During the course of treatment at SCB, she lost her life. Her family was under financial stress to transfer her mortal remains back to their native place.

Odisha-Mo Parivar stepped in to help the family in all documentation processes and also provided logistical support to transfer the mortal remains from SCB, Cuttack to Ganjam.

After his check-up, he was provided with required medicines at the hospital.

Odisha-Mo Parivar along with Yuva Utkal Foundation provided him dry ration for a month and clothes. Thereafter he was taken back to his home and followed-up for monthly health check-up.

Providing the wheels of fortune

Nitu Behera, who has lost the ability to walk since her childhood, is completely dependent on wheelchair for mobilization and day to day activities.

The 40-year-old had been using a wheelchair, received from a voluntary organization 15 years ago, which was completely destroyed, hindering her day to day activities.

She being financially weak, had been requesting various organizations for a wheelchair, but was futile in her attempts to procure one.

Ms Nitu Behera was provided with a wheelchair and was assured all support in future to make her self-sufficient.



Major interventions by Helpdesk Operators

1 BSKY TO THE RESCUE

- 45-year-old Shantilata Patnaik diagnosed with breast cancer was admitted to SUM, Hospital Bhubaneswar on 8th September.
- Helpdesk operator Siba Rout helped the patient in the admission, documentation process and medical tests.
- Siba enrolled the patient under the BSKY Scheme for free treatment. The surgery was successful and the patient has expressed her gratitude for the service rendered by Odisha-Mo Parivar.

Logistical arrangements made by Girija

- 62 year old E. Madhav Dora of Ganjam district suffered from heart attack and was admitted to MKCG, Berhampur who was in need of an ICU.
- Help Desk operator Girija immediately attended to the patient and as per the doctor's advice, the patient was provided logistical support and transferred to Hi-Tech Hospital, Bhubaneswar.
- Girija coordinated with Hi-Tech hospital staff for the treatment of the patient under BSKY scheme and assisted the family in all required documentation process for the same.

2 DELICATE HANDLING

- 11 month old Sonali Bagi was admitted to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar in a very critical condition and was diagnosed with brain tumor with accumulation of fluid in brain.
 - She was under critical care treatment for more than 2 months, where all navigational help and required blood was provided by Somanth during the course of treatment.
- The child has finally recovered and discharged from the hospital.

- A 2 days old baby of Mamata Naik was admitted to VIMSAR Burla in a critical condition. The doctor advised to shift the baby to SCB, Cuttack on an immediate basis in the wee hours of 22nd September.
- Helpdesk associate Dharendra Suna, upon getting the information, immediately reached out to the family and made logistical arrangements for the family to shift the patient from VIMSAR, Burla to SCB, Cuttack.

- Somnath helped him to get medicines from the medicine store outside the campus as it was not available in the hospital. He also took him to the bus stand & booked a bus ticket for him to return to his home.

The family members of the patient are also helped in getting affordable accommodation in the vicinity of the concerned hospital. In the month of September 2021, Odisha-Mo Parivar through Konark Cancer Foundation, intervened in 28 such cases and a regular follow-up is being maintained.

The vision of **Honourable Chief Minister** has been to provide assurance of quality health care to all the citizens of the State, especially the vulnerable sections. With this objective, Biju Swasthya Kalyan Yojana has been launched which is a path breaking program to provide universal health coverage, with special emphasis on the health protection of economically vulnerable families.

Provision

Free health services for all in all State Government health care facilities starting from Sub centre level up to District Head Quarter Hospital level.

Free health services for all persons, such as free drugs, free diagnostics, free dialysis, free Cancer chemotherapy, free OT, free I.C.U, free in-patient admission etc., in all state government health institutions.

Annual health coverage of Rs 5 lakh per annum per family and Rs 10 lakh per annum for women members of the family

Who is eligible?

All families are eligible for health care services at Government health care Institutions.

All BSKY Smart Card holders and NFSA/ SFSA card holder are eligible to avail the special health coverage, for which State Government will bear the cost.

92.5 lakh economically vulnerable families in the state will be covered under the scheme

How to avail the benefit

Families covered under NFSA / SFSA with in Odisha are auto-enrolled under this scheme.

All eligible families can apply online through the BSKY helpdesks at empaneled hospitals.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who is there to facilitate at point of service?

Swasthya Mitras are deployed at each help desk of empanelled private hospitals to facilitate the beneficiaries.

2. During emergency can I avail cashless treatment at any empanelled hospitals without carrying a card?

Yes, all BSKY Smart Card holders are eligible to avail the cashless treatment at empanelled private hospitals even during emergencies, provided they submit the BSKY Smart Card at the counter within 72 hours of hospitalization.

3. How many members in a family are eligible to avail cashless treatment under BSKY at empanelled private hospitals?

All the registered family members under NFSA/ SFSA who are issued with BSKY Smart Card, are eligible to avail the scheme.

4. How to get duplicate BSKY card if original card is lost/ damaged?

If a beneficiary either loses/ damages his / her card then the same can be obtained from nearest Mo Seva Kendra by producing his/her NFSA/ SFSA (Ration) card.

5. How to get card related information and also rectify errors in the card such as adding or deleting a member from card?

Card related information can be accessed from the web-portal "bsky.odisha.gov.in" or from Mo Seva Kendra service point. Any error relating to card can be rectified at Mo Seva Kendra after producing NFSA/SFSA (Ration) card.

6. Where to get the list of empanelled hospitals for availing health-related services using BSKY Smart Health Card?

The list of empanelled hospitals within or outside the state is available in the web portal "bsky.odisha.gov.in".

7. How do we calculate annual coverage amount for male and female member of the family?

If in a family, there are two members, one male member and another woman member then,

- If a male member falls sick and exhausts Rs 3 Lakh from BSKY Smart Health card and then the woman member falls sick, she can avail upto Rs 7 lakh under the card.
- If a male member doesn't fall sick and only the female member of the family falls sick, she can avail upto Rs 10 lakh under the card.
- If a woman member falls sick and exhausts Rs 3 lakh from BSKY smart health card, then if a male members falls sick, he can avail Rs 2 lakh from the card.

8. Is there a feedback mechanism in the BSKY?

Yes, the State Government will take direct feedback from the beneficiaries and the Hospitals regarding the implementation of the program. The citizens can also provide feedback on the Mo Sarkar Call centre Number-14545.

JEEVAN BINDU BLOOD DONATION PROGRAM

After taking into consideration the stock and requirements of all the 56 Blood Banks in Odisha, target based blood donation camps are organized under Odisha Mo Parivar- Jeevan Bindu Program. The targets for every month is intimated to the Jeevan Bindu coordinators well in advance so that they can make the required arrangements for conducting the camps and coordinate with the blood banks accordingly.

Total target for the month of September was 10,000 units out of which 7305 units have been collected despite incessant rains and deferment of camps to October 2nd.

EYE CHECKUP CAMP

Under the aegis of Odisha-Mo Parivar, MLA Nuapada Shri Rajendra Dholakia organized an Eye check-up Camp in collaboration with Kanchan Ben Rasiklal Dholakia Charitable Trust at Titlagarh. Out of 150 eye patients, 58 cataract patients were referred to SCD Eye Hospital, Titlagarh for free eye operations. 88 patients received free power glass & medicines.
