Odisha-Mo Parivar has always stood by the needy and distressed throughout the state and even across the globe. In the month of May, Odisha-Mo Parivar came to know about a very sad story about a needy family through a publication in a media house.

It was found that, Bebina Nayak, a 42-year-old resident of Satyanagar, Bhubaneswar was left alone by her husband. She was already struggling to earn a bread for her two children, when another burden came into their lives. Bebina's both kidney got affected and she was admitted to AIIMS Bhubaneswar. It was difficult

for Bebina to undergo treatment and run the family due to financial stress. Finding no other option, Bebina's 13-year-old son stepped out to sell vegetables and arrange funds so that the treatment could continue.

Upon getting information regarding this, our helpdesk associate Somnath Swain stationed at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar stood by the patient and helped in all required medical assistance. Also in coordination with the Tahasildar, financial assistance was provided to the family. Somnath also helped in updating the ration card of Bebina so that they can avail

monthly ration easily. Bebina expressed her gratitude towards Somnath and Odisha-Mo Parivar for standing by her like her family during the time of need.

Bhikari Naik, a 22-year-old resident of Badakodanda, Ganjam was working as a daily laborer in Kerala. While at the working site (building demolition), he met with an accident and unfortunately breathed his last on 17th May 2022.

The family approached Odisha-Mo Parivar, seeking help to bring back the mortal remains from Government medical College, Thrissur to their native place at Badakodanda, Ganjam. Immediate steps were taken to bring back the mortal remains from Kerala to Bhubaneswar by Air.

Odisha-Mo Parivar team reached the airport and received the mortal remains while making logistical arrangements to transfer it to their native place at Ganjam.

A mother goes through intense pain both mentally and physically while delivering a child, where she needs immense care and support of her near ones. But it was very unfortunate to witness a helpless mother who was left alone by her husband at MKCG hospital premises and there was no one to take care of her.

Somehow, she could manage to contact MLA Sri Bikram Panda and intimated about her situation. Immediately, Sri Panda informed the matter to our helpdesk associate Girija Satpathy, who reached at the hospital and got the pregnant lady admitted.

Not only this, since there was no attendant, Girija himself signed the required documents for further procedures. The lady gave birth to a baby girl and was overjoyed to see the newborn baby in her arms and thanked Girija for helping her as a brother.

Mortal remains brought back from Kerala by Odisha-Mo Parivar

Santosh Sobhanayak, a 37-year-old resident of Mohana, Gajapati was working at Ernakulam, Kerala. He met with an accident and was admitted to a nearby hospital where he was declared dead.

The family who were under financial stress had approached their local administration to bring back the mortal remains. Further, BDO, Mohana intimated the matter to Odisha-Mo Parivar and

requested to coordinate in the process.

Odisha-Mo Parivar team coordinated the entire process and the mortal remains after reaching the International Airport Bhubaneswar, was received by Odisha-Mo Parivar team. Also, logistical arrangements were made to transfer the mortal remains from the airport to their native place at Mohana, Gajapati.

Sri Samal coordinated in bringing back the mortal remains from Pune to Bhubaneswar. Further, MLA and member Odisha-Mo Parivar Sri Sanjeev Mallick and Sri Samal intimated the matter to Odisha-Mo Parivar for logistical assistance to transfer the mortal remains from the Airport to Bhadrak.

Odisha-Mo Parivar team reached the airport and made required arrangements to transfer the mortal remains to their native place at Bhadrak.

Banabash Naik was the sole bread-winner of the family. One of his relatives staying in Kerala, approached the CM's office seeking help to transfer the mortal remains. The matter was intimated to Odisha-Mo Parivar and immediate steps were taken to expedite the required medical

procedures at the hospital and logistical arrangements were made to transfer the mortal remains from the hospital to their native place.

Kshitish was the only earning member of the family. The bereaved family approached Sri Suwendu Das Mangaraj seeking logistical help to transfer the mortal remains from Bhubaneswar airport to their native place. Sri Mangaraj intimated the matter to Odisha-Mo Parivar. The team reached the airport, received the mortal remains and made logistical arrangements to transfer it to their native place at Mayurbhanj.

Prabhakar Mallick, a 40-year-old, resident of Sanakhemundi, Ganjam had met with an accident and was admitted to SCB, Cuttack.

Unfortunately, he breathed his last while undergoing treatment on 5th May 2022. Our helpdesk associate Sandeep Rath had been following up with the case. After the demise of Sri Mallick, the family members approached seeking help to transfer the mortal remains.

Upon getting the information, from Sandeep, logistical arrangements were made to transfer the mortal remains from SCB Hospital, Cuttack to their native place at Sanakhemundi, Ganjam.

1 Provided Rare Group of Blood

1 Pabitra Muduli, a 39-year-old resident of Puri had met with an accident and was admitted to Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar for treatment.

There was a dire need of rare A-ve blood for an emergency surgery. Our helpdesk associate Bikash Behera upon getting the information, arranged 1 unit of the rare A-ve blood in nick of time for the patient.

2 Gayatri Maharana, a 35-year-old resident of Berhampur suffering from gynecological issues was admitted to MKCG Berhampur.

During the course of the treatment, there was an urgent need of rare A-ve blood for the patient. The family was unable to arrange the required blood and approached our helpdesk associate Girija who immediately arranged a donor for the patient.

During the course of the treatment, there was a drop in her haemoglobin level and the patient was in need of urgent blood transfusion. The family was unable to arrange the rare AB+ ve blood and approached our helpdesk associate Himansu who immediately arranged a donor for the patient.

The family was under financial stress and our helpdesk associate at Koraput, Sri Baikuntha Mandal with the help of the district administration made required arrangements while our helpdesk associates at SCB, Cuttack, Sandeep and Santosh coordinated in the entire process to transfer the mortal remains from SCB, Cuttack to Koraput.

4 Ranjan Ali, a 78-year-old resident of Rourkela had met with an accident and his leg was amputated. He had visited VIMSAR Burla for doctor's consultation

The patient was attended by our helpdesk associate Dharendra Suna who helped the patient in getting doctor's consultation and required medical tests. The patient was referred to SCB, Cuttack for plastic surgery and our helpdesk associate made required arrangements for the same.

Suwendu Swain, a 33-year-old resident of Cuttack and a Snake Rescue Volunteer by profession had met with an accident while going to a site to rescue a snake. Unfortunately his leg was amputated after the incident.

He was unable to continue with his rescue operations and upon getting information regarding the provision of prosthetics by Odisha-Mo Parivar he approached seeking help to avail prosthetics. Immediately his case was taken care of and he was provided with prosthetics through ARC Capital hospital.



Akash Bal, a 11-year-old boy of Balasore district was suffering from cancer in his left leg and was admitted to AIIMS Bhubaneswar. In order to stop the cancer to spread further, his leg was amputated. Our helpdesk associate Somnath had been following up with the patient starting from his admission till discharge. Later he was guided to visit ARC Capital hospital where he was provided with prosthetics.



Subasis Paikray, a 28-year-old resident of Badamba, Cuttack had been affected with infection on his left leg since 10 years, which could not be cured. In order to stop the spread of infection the doctor advised for amputation. 3 months back his left leg below knee was amputated. He had not availed prosthetic since then. He visited Odisha-Mo Parivar headquarters seeking help to avail prosthetics and was guided to visit ARC Capital hospital, where he was provided with prosthetics.



Gagan Samal, a 58-year-old resident of Cuttack while digging a well met with an accident and suffered severe injuries on his leg. The injury led to infection with time and the doctor advised for amputation. His left leg was amputated below knee 2 years back. He had approached Odisha-Mo Parivar seeking help for availing prosthetics. He was guided to visit ARC Capital hospital, where he was provided with prosthetics.

Unsung HERO

*“A kind gesture can reach a wound
that only compassion can heal.”*

The true example of this is Mr. Prafulla Kumar Senapati, the inspiration behind the **Jeevan Jyoti Ashram, Bhubaneswar**. After losing his father at a very early age, he was adopted by his Aja (maternal grandfather), who wanted him to manage his large holding of properties in the village. Mr. Senapati finished his high school and enrolled in college even as he felt a lack of purpose in his life. Having missed the love and care of parents in his early years, his mind was filled with thoughts of helping the needy.

A critical event that occurred during a trip to Bhubaneswar in 2002 provided a new direction to Mr. Senapati's life. He met two children who had



been abandoned on the roadside by their family. After notifying the police, he took the kids to his village. However, as his family was very resistant to raise the children, Mr. Senapati decided to bring them back to Bhubaneswar where he was able to find an ashram that agreed to shelter them. A small piece of land was located nearby and the ashram moved into a sturdier building in 2005 through small donations from many people.

As word spread in the community about the care the orphans were receiving, senior citizens started showing up at the door seeking shelter. A small step with pure dedication has led to an ocean of happiness to many abandoned children, providing them with a home, love, happiness, physical, mental, emotional and spiritual nourishment, the highest level of education possible and a hope for a bright future.

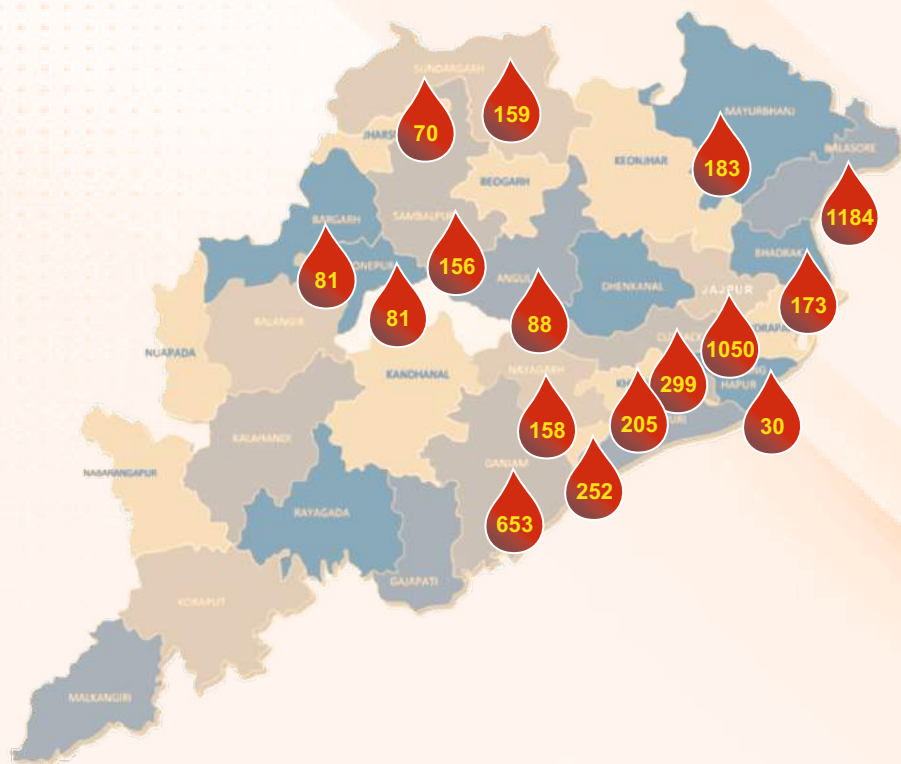

JEEVAN BINDU BLOOD DONATION PROGRAM

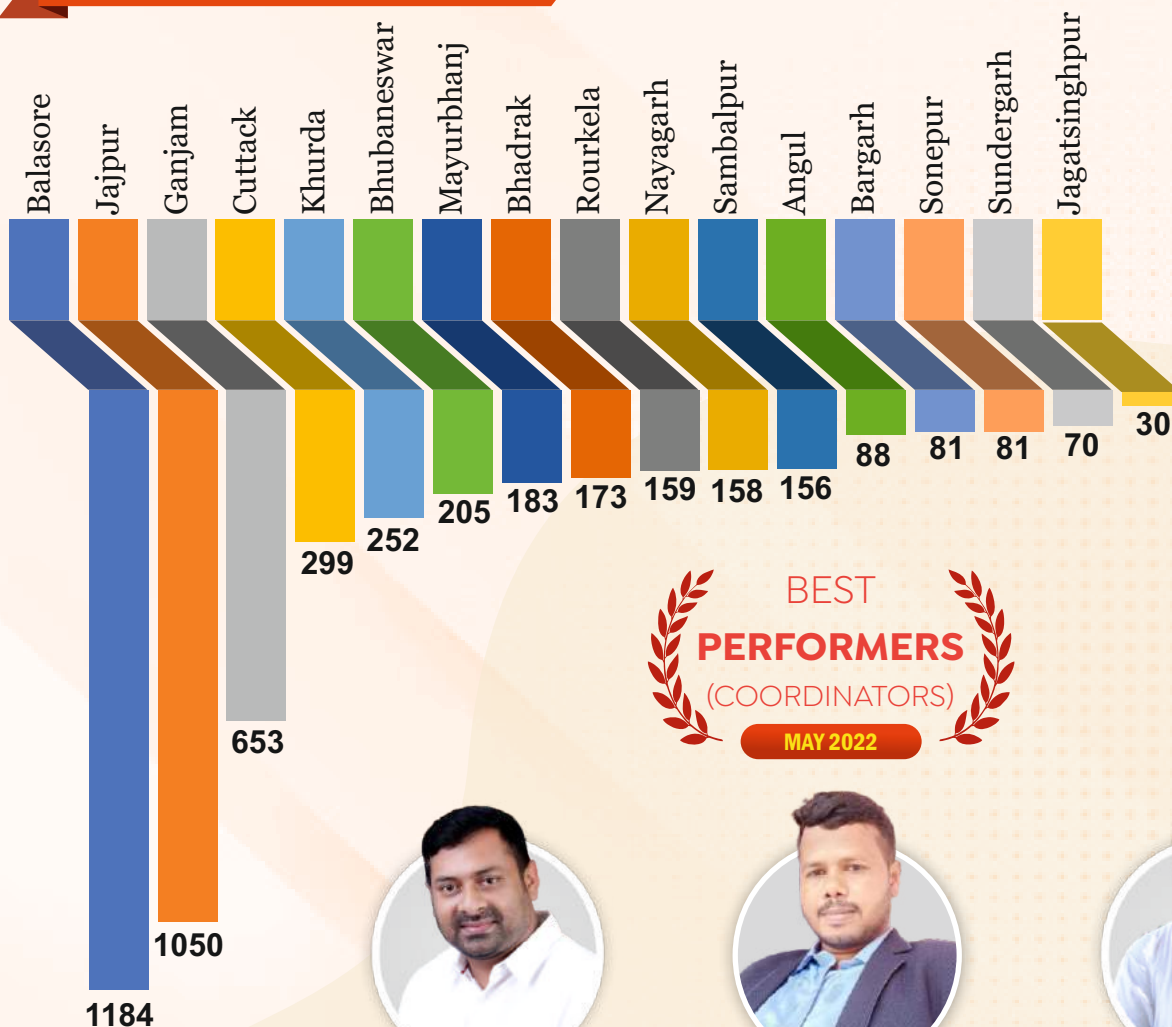
“Your little effort can give others second chance to live life”.

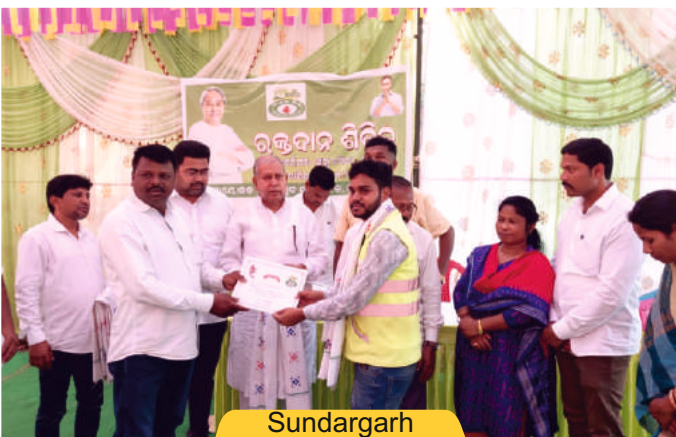

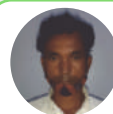
