Dental Camp by Odisha-Mo Parivar

The family members were grief-stricken as Purna was the sole breadwinner of the family and in such a helpless situation they approached Sri Manoj Kumar Nayak, Director, Odia Mahamanch-Delhi, to bring back the mortal remains.

Sri Nayak intimated the matter to Odisha-Mo Parivar and logistical arrangements were made to transfer the mortal remains. Odisha-Mo Parivar team received the mortal remains at the Bhubaneswar International Airport and made arrangements for transferring it to their native place at Jajpur.

3-year-old Janhavi Oram, a resident of Rourkela, Odisha, suffering from muscle atrophy in lungs, was admitted to KIMS, Bhubaneswar in September 2021. The family was under financial stress and had approached Odisha-Mo Parivar for help in the treatment process.

Odisha-Mo Parivar helped in all documentation procedures of the patient and the treatment was carried out under the BSKY Scheme. After undergoing treatment for 5 months, the patient was discharged on 9th February 2022.

The family approached Odisha-Mo Parivar for logistical help and the arrangements were made in the wee hours to shift the patient to their native place at Rourkela. The family members expressed their gratitude to Odisha-Mo Parivar for the selfless service starting from admission till the discharge of the patient.

The bereaved family approached Odisha-Mo Parivar for logistical help and arrangements were made to transfer the mortal remains from SCB, Cuttack to their native place at Jajpur.

65 Stranded Odia rescued from Hyderabad

65 laborers, who are resident of Nuapada district had been to Hyderabad since November 2021 to work in a brick kiln factory (Silsila Chandrabhati Kiln).

They were being tortured and their wages were withheld by the contractor. They had appealed through a video to rescue them.

After getting the information regarding the situation, Odisha-Mo Parivar discussed the matter with MLA Nuapada and with the relentless efforts of MLA Sri Rajendra Dholakia & DLO-Nuapada, all the 65 Odia laborers were rescued back to Odisha.

After getting the information, Odisha-Mo Parivar team immediately reached the Hi-Tech Hospital, Bhubaneswar, facilitated in all required documentation procedures and made logistical arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from the hospital to their native place at Rayagada.

After reaching Odisha, Santosh approached the Hon'ble CM's office seeking logistical help to travel to their native. After getting information regarding the same, Odisha-Mo Parivar made logistical arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from the Biju Patnaik International airport to their native place at Sanakhemundi.

"I will continue to serve the community as long as I can, even if I am differently abled."

Dinabandhu Das, a 36-year-old man from Chhatrapur village in Ganjam district, has been suffering from polio since his birth and has lost his ability to walk.

Despite the difficulties, he runs a small shoe shop for his daily earning to feed his wife and two sons. Since his childhood, he has a keen interest in social work. As he has seen the pain and suffering from close quarters, he has been passionate about donating blood to save lives so that others can get rid of pain and sorrow.

Dinabandhu has donated blood for 76 times till date. Such selfless people are rare in this society, who has set an example by living the life for the benefit of others.

MAJOR INTERVENTIONS BY HELPDESK COORDINATORS

1. HELPED WITH RARE BLOOD GROUP

Abhijit Mohanty, a 28-year-old resident of Khorda district had met with an accident and was admitted to AIIMS, Bhubaneswar.

There was an urgent need of rare A-ve blood for a surgery of the patient, which the family were unable to arrange. They came in contact with our helpdesk associate Somnath Swain, who arranged 2 units of blood for the patient.

Debashree Rout, a 24-year-old resident of Baripada, detected with tumor in her leg, was admitted to SCB, Cuttack for her surgery. There was a dire need of rare O-ve blood for her surgery which the family were unable to arrange.

Our helpdesk associate Santosh Das, upon getting the information, arranged two units of the rare O-ve blood in nick of time for the patient.

Bishnupriya Mishra, a 32-year-old resident of Puri suffering from kidney related issue was admitted to DHH, Puri.

During the course of treatment, the patient's haemoglobin level dropped and the doctor suggested for immediate blood transfusion, which the family members were unable to arrange. Upon getting the information, our helpdesk associate Biswo arranged one unit of the rare O-ve blood in nick of time.

Swarmlata Bagari, a 10-days-old child was admitted to Sishu Bhawan Hospital, Cuttack. There was a dire need of rare O-ve blood for the child during the course of the treatment which the family was unable to arrange.

Our helpdesk associate Sandeep, upon getting the information, arranged one unit of the rare O-ve blood in nick of time.

2. LOGISTICAL ARRANGEMENTS



Logistical arrangements made to shift the patient from SUM hospital to Sundergarh

Topon Toppo, a 50-year-old resident of Sundergarh district, suffering from blood cancer, was admitted to SUM Hospital, Bhubaneswar.

As per the doctor's advice he was discharged on 2nd Feb. Our helpdesk associate Siba Prasad Rout, who had been maintaining a follow-up with the patient, made logistical arrangements to shift the patient from the hospital to their native place in Sundergarh.

Gouranga Oram, a 40-year-old resident of Jharsuguda was admitted to VIMSAR, Burla because of continuous blood vomiting.

Our helpdesk associate Dhirendra helped the family members in all required medical assistance and maintained a follow-up with the patient. He also made logistical arrangements for the family after the patient got recovered and discharged from the hospital.

Upon getting the information, our helpdesk associate Girija Satpathy made logistical arrangements to shift the mortal remains back to their native place in Nabarangpur.

Since the family were unable to arrange an ambulance, our helpdesk associate Asish made arrangements to shift the patient from the hospital to SCB, Cuttack.

The patient was under financial stress and upon getting information, our helpdesk associate Biswo with the help of JeevanBindu joint coordinator Puri made necessary arrangements for the patient.

The doctor advised to shift her to SCB, Cuttack for further treatment. Our helpdesk associate Biswo made arrangements to shift them to SCB, Cuttack and coordinated with helpdesk associate Santosh Das at SCB, Cuttack to take care of the patient.

Budhia Singh, a 40-year-old resident of Badasahi, Mayurbhanj who had consumed poison, was admitted to PRMMCH, Baripada in a critical condition.

Our helpdesk associate Asish Rana maintained a regular follow-up with the patient. But unfortunately during the course of treatment, the patient breathed his last and the family members approached for logistical help and Asish made the require arrangements for the same.

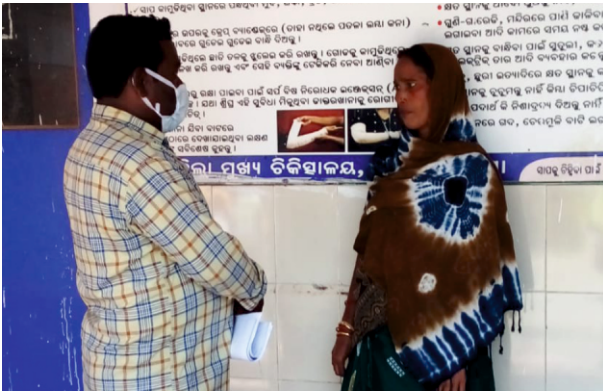


Logistical arrangements made to transfer mortal remains from VIMSAR, Burla to Bargarh

The entire process was coordinated by Health Advisor (Odisha-Mo Parivar) Dr. Satyajit Dash.



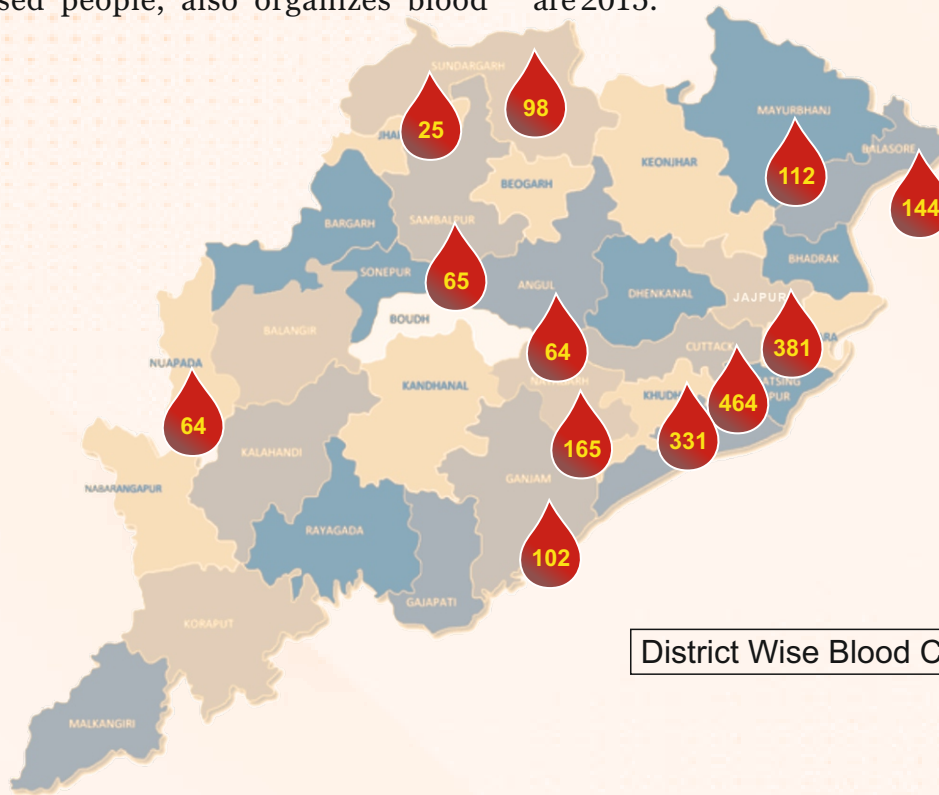

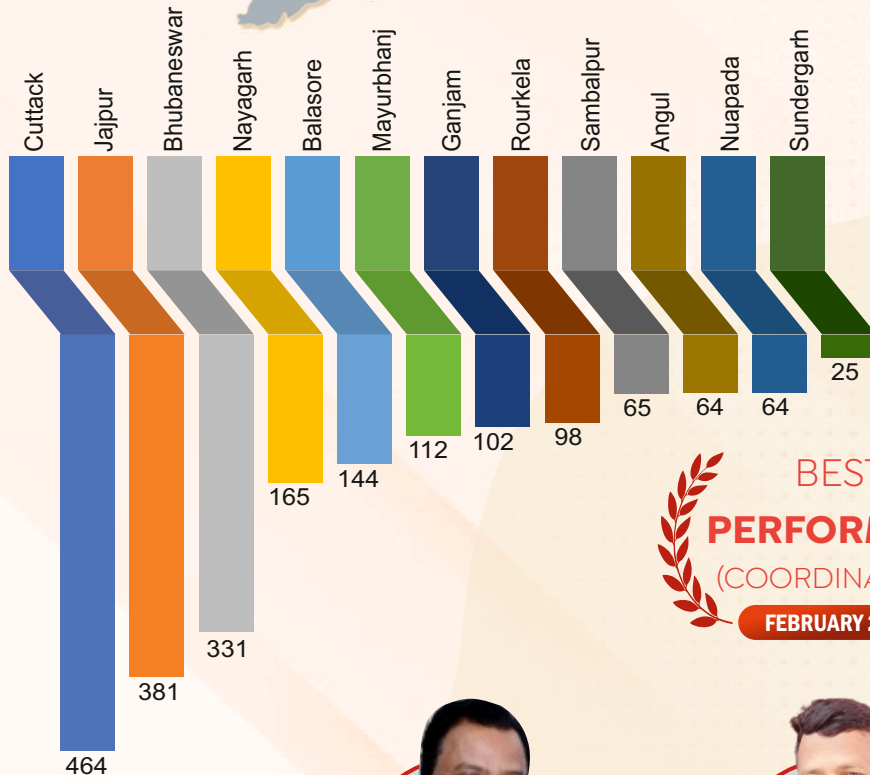
With this thought, Odisha-Mo Parivar, which always makes efforts to stand by the needy and distressed people, also organizes blood

Mumbai through Konark Cancer Foundation, which is a NGO with the sole aim of providing logistical, emotional and financial support to the cancer patients. All required assistance was provided by the entire team throughout the process. But surprisingly, the test reports turned to be negative at Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai.

The family members were relieved after the tests and were grateful towards the selfless service provided by Odisha-Mo Parivar team and Konark Cancer Foundation team at Mumbai.

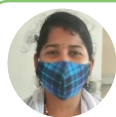
