Body Recovered And Handed Over To Family

Pamu Anuram, a 20-year-old, native of Gopalpur, Ganjam, had been to Gopalpur beach along with his family and friends.

The family returned to their home but Pamu stayed back mentioning that he would like to spend some more time with his friends.

While playing in the sea, he went deep inside and couldn't be traced. The rescue team searched for around 7 long days and on 16th July his body was recovered from Srikakulam beach. The body was kept in Palasa Govt Hospital, Srikakulam.

The family who were completely broken, reached at the hospital and approached Odisha-Mo Parivar seeking logistical help to transfer the mortal remains. Upon getting the information, immediate steps were taken to bring back the mortal remains from the hospital to their native place in Ganjam. Also, the required documentation process was expedited with the police and medical authorities. Our Jeevan Bindu coordinator Shri Subash Maharana stood by the family members during the last rites.

Mortal remains brought back from Surat

Ghanshyam Behera, a 36-year-old resident of Hinjilicut, Ganjam was working at Ultratech in Surat.

On 15th July, after returning home from his work he was busy in repairing a fan in his room which was out of order. While repairing, he got a severe shock from the wire and fell on the ground unconscious. Immediately, he was taken to SMIMER, Surat by his roommates but unfortunately he was declared dead.

The bereaved family were broken completely with the news, since he was the only son and the sole bread winner of the family. They approached their local Sarpanch seeking help to bring back the mortal remains so that they can see their son for the last time. After getting information from the Sarpanch, immediate steps were taken by Odisha-Mo Parivar to expedite the medical procedures and bring the mortal remains back to their native place in Ganjam from Surat.

Dina Padhiyari, a 46-year-old Rresident of Ganjam, was undergoing treatment at SCB, Cuttack.

Unfortunately, she breathed her last while undergoing treatment. The bereaved family approached Odisha-Mo Parivar seeking logistical support to transfer the mortal remains. Upon getting the information, required arrangements were made to expedite the paper works at the hospital and transfer the mortal remains from the hospital to their native place in Ganjam. Our helpdesk associate Sandeep Rath coordinated the entire process.

Bapuji Polai, a 34-year-old resident of Jahada, Ganjam was working as a laborer at Kerala.

He was not well and was travelling back to his native at Ganjam. Unfortunately, he breathed his last in the train & his body was received by the police at Avadi Railway Station. From the station, the body was sent to KMC Hospital, Avadi by the GRP. The family upon getting the information, approached Odisha-Mo Parivar seeking help to bring back the mortal remains.

Odisha-Mo Parivar made required arrangements to expedite the required medical procedure and transfer the mortal remains from the hospital to their native place at Ganjam and Sri Subash Maharana, our Jeevan Bindu coordinator stood by the family members during the last rites.

usmant Mohanty, 32-year-old KalingaTV's Kamakhyanagar reporter, met with a tragic accident on 25th July.

While on his way to cover a news at Bhuban, Dhenkanal block office, he was hit by a vehicle in front of the Bhuban police station. He was rescued by Bhuban Police and rushed to Government hospital, Bhuban but as his condition deteriorated, he was shifted to SCB, Cuttack.

But unfortunately he lost his life during the course of his treatment at Cuttack. Since the service of Odisha-Mo Parivar is known to all the media houses, they approached seeking help to transfer the mortal remains of the deceased. Upon getting the information, our helpdesk associate reached the hospital and required arrangements were made to transfer the mortal remains from the hospital to their native place.

Hrudayananda Pradhan, a 39year-old resident of Sanakhemundi, suffering from blood cancer was undergoing treatment at Utkal hospital, Bhubaneswar.

Unfortunately, he breathed his last during the course of treatment on 28th July 2022. The family was burdened with financial stress and approached Odisha-Mo Parivar seeking help to transfer the mortal remains.

Upon getting the information, team Odisha-Mo Parivar immediately reached at the hospital, assisted the family in required medical procedures and made required logistical arrangements to transfer the mortal remains from the hospital to their native place at Sanakhemundi, Ganjam.


Further, he was directed to ARC, Capital hospital to avail prosthetics and expressed his gratitude after receiving the prosthetics.

02. Abhimanyu Naik



Abhimanyu Naik had met with an accident on 25th January 2019, where he suffered severe injuries on his left leg. In the accident his bone got completely damaged due to which the doctor advised for leg amputation. His left leg was amputated on 26th January 2019 above knee. First he had availed prosthetics from Olatpur which got damaged. Later, he availed a prosthetics from ALIMCO which was not comfortable enough.

He approached Odisha-Mo Parivar to avail prosthetics and was directed to ARC, Capital hospital to avail prosthetics and expressed his gratitude after receiving the prosthetics.








BLOOD DONATION CAMP

Odisha-Mo Parivar through its flagship program "Jeevan Bindu" organizes blood donation camps throughout the state to maintain a proper stock in all the blood banks for people with disorders like Thalassemia, Sickle Cells and Haemophilia, who require blood in regular intervals and for emergency blood requirements in hospitals.

Taking the capacity of the blood banks, current stock of blood and requirement into consideration, a total of **10858** units of blood were collected in the month of July.







On the completion of 25 years of Biju Janata Dal Odisha special programmes and events are being organised throughout the state such as blood donation camps, plantation drives, organ donation drives etc. Programmes for the month of July are as follows:

Multiple blood donation camps organized under the leadership of MLA Shri Pranab Kumar Balabantaray on the occassion of the death anniversary of late Sri Kalpataru Das at Dharmashala, Jajpur which were coordinated by Jeevan Bindu coordinator Shri Bimal Chandra Das where a record total of **2557** units were collected.







Jeevan Bindu joint coordinator (Puri) Shri Stalin Parija organized a blood donation camp at Puri, where a total of 103 units were collected. Simultaneously a plantation program was also organized where 25 saplings were planted. Also, 25 people came forward in this program & registered themselves for organ donation.

A blood donation camp was organized under the leadership of BMJD President MLA Smt. Snehagini Chhuria at BYJD office Bhubaneswar where total of 149 units were collected out of which 129 were women donors.
