Pamu Anuram, a 20-year-old, native of Gopalpur, Ganjam, had been to Gopalpur beach along with his family and friends.

The family returned to their home but Pamu stayed back mentioning that he would like to spend some more time with his friends.

While playing in the sea, he went deep inside and couldn't be traced. The rescue team searched for around 7 long days and on 16th July his body was recovered from Srikakulam beach. The body was kept in Palasa Govt Hospital, Srikakulam.

The family who were completely broken, reached at the hospital and approached Odisha-Mo Parivar seeking logistical help to transfer the mortal remains. Upon getting the information, immediate steps were taken to bring back the mortal remains from the hospital to their native place in Ganjam. Also, the required documentation process was expedited with the police and medical authorities. Our Jeevan Bindu coordinator Shri Subash Maharana stood by the family members during the last rites.

Ghanshyam Behera, a 36-year-old resident of Hinjilicut, Ganjam was working at Ultratech in Surat.

On 15th July, after returning home from his work he was busy in repairing a fan in his room which was out of order. While repairing, he got a severe shock from the wire and fell on the ground unconscious. Immediately, he was taken to SMIMER, Surat by his roommates but unfortunately he was declared dead.

The bereaved family were broken completely with the news, since he was the only son and the sole bread winner of the family. They

approached their local Sarpanch seeking help to bring back the mortal remains so that they can see their son for the last time. After getting information from the Sarpanch, immediate steps were taken by Odisha-Mo Parivar to expedite the medical procedures and bring the mortal remains back to their native place in Ganjam from Surat.

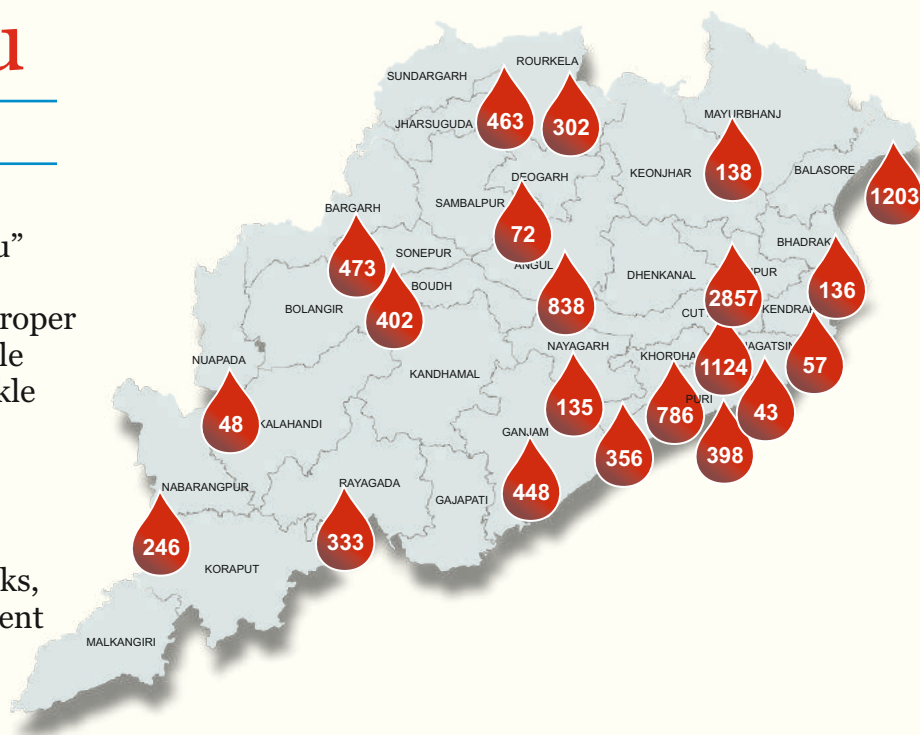

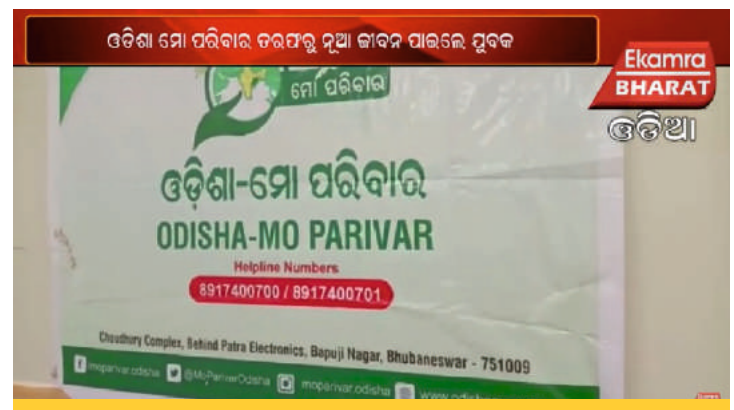
